# WARR Report Amsterdam 5th 7th September 2019

Warr returned to Amsterdam after an absence of 13 years. This was in part, to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the founding of KLM, the oldest airline still with the same name, although Qantas holds the record for being the oldest continuously operating airline from its home base.

The city allowed for plenty of sightseeing including the iconic windmills at Zander See, just outside of Amsterdam.

The meet and greet party, as well as the t shirt swap were held at the Heineken experience once its prime brewery. The t shirt competition was won by Air Canada.



Thanks to Justin Burt from London for arriving with some specially designed Qantas Amsterdam t shirts which will be a collector's item in the future.

Unfortunately, Di Morey broke one ankle and sprained the other, prior to Warr and Rosa Wallis also injured herself enroute to WARR and was a non-starter. Anne Campbell stepped in and attended the Team Captains meeting which is in a separate report.

Race day was overcast with a short shower before the start. The course was through the Amsterdam Forest (Bos) which made for a beautifully scenic run. The surprise was KLM had 1300 runners including their CEO, which just added to the atmosphere.

This made obtaining a place a challenge and you can see individual results below. Our outstanding runner was the perennial John Burroughs who was first overall airline/nonairline in his age category for the 5km. Neil Campbell came a creditable 4<sup>th</sup> as he stepped into a new age category this year.

In a change from previous WARRs where a formal buffet dinner is held with awards present there, this year most awards were presented after the race.

The After Party started early at 1600 in a warehouse with unlimited food from Food trucks. This new concept allowed all the runners to easily mingle and not be allocated to a set table. All who attended said they enjoyed the concept though I hear some runners did miss dressing up.

Whilst no runner came home with a trophy the team picked up the participation award for the Pacific Rim.

### **TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING**

The meeting in KLM headquarters building was well attended with most airline represented by a mix of experienced Warriors and New ones.

The meetings have been very professionally run for the past few years.

There was a full report on the financials where it was explained how the International Warr Committee (IWC) endeavours to have the host committee donate 10 % to charity.

The financial figures from 2018 Victoria Canada were impressive with sizeable sponsorship helping them.

Jenn stressed the need for Airlines to engage with the new Warriors to become Team captains to reinvigorate the event.

All team captains introduced themselves, stated how many WARR's they had attended and how many people were in their teams. Many had teams of 50 plus which was encouraging.

No one nominated for the position of Chairman so Jenn said she would do another year but stressed we need to renew the chairperson at least every 5 years.

As usual everyone wanted to know where WARR would be held next year.

Jenn indicated since no airline had nominated, then the IWC would endeavour to host the event by leveraging off an existing run somewhere in the world, likely in October 2020. This would mean warriors registering for that Race, with side events such as T shirt swap etc. held at some locality nearby. This is similar to what KLM did by combining Warr with a KLM staff members run.

Jenn indicated her preference was for Hawaii or Australia (note QRC had previously declined to host) so we will all get behind the IWC to host WARR wherever they decide. Rumour has it that 2021 will be in either Europe or America.
